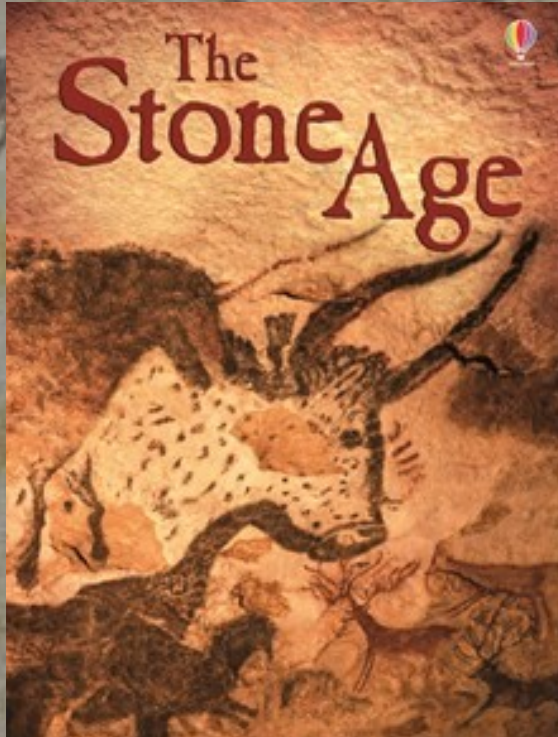
Complete all the activities on:

Find out about the indigenous people of North Sentinel Island in Asia. How does their lifestyle compare to that of prehistoric humans? Make an information collage about this interesting tribe.

Write your own Prehistoric adventure Story.

Research Stone Age monuments and Long Barrows in our area, (Rollright stones, Belas Knap). Design or make your own 3D monument.

Iron Age people started growing crops (Spelt, barley, rye & oats); can you find these in the shops? Where are these crops grown now? List your findings in a table.

Draw your own pet or a local animal in the style of a prehistoric cave painting.
