Clubs

We are delighted so many children are taking advantage of our after school club opportunities please do remember that children must be collected promptly at the end of clubs at 4:15. Staff have other commitments after this time and late collection may raise safeguarding concerns. Please also let us know in advance (before the end of school day 3:20) if your child cannot attend a club session or will be collected by someone different.

If your child is in our Year 5 Verbal/ Non Verbal Reasoning club with Miss Campbell and Mrs Reaney payment for books for these sessions is now overdue. Pupils will be unable to participate in sessions after next week if the books are not purchased. Please see a separate email sent last week with further details.

Please note that no staff led clubs will be running 22- 26 October due to parents' evenings. Multi sport and Starstruck will take place as normal.

Medical Appointments

A reminder that whenever possible medical appointments should be booked outside of school hours. Please do not turn up without notice to collect your child as non teaching staff may not be available to assist. Children are not routinely released for early collection as this causes disruption to learning and absences for appointments which are not for the child themselves will not be authorised. Please ensure that if you have a personal appointment which will affect your ability to collect your child at the end of day that you make alternative childcare arrangements.

Hair

A reminder that children should attend school with smart and sensible hairstyles. Hair should not be shaved with motifs and excessive styling products should not be used. Long hair should be tied back and preferable braided to help us keep the spread of headlice to a minimum. Please ensure that any hair accessories are appropriately sized and coloured for school, for example hair bows should be imple, plain and smaller than 10cm.

Telephoning home

A reminder that we will not telephone home for missing kit. We hold contact information for emergency purposes only such as contacting parents for illness or regarding collection. All other communication will be via email and Dojo.

Contacting staff

Please respect the right of staff to a personal life and do not seek to engage them in a conversation about a school matter when they are off the premises at a non school event. If you need to make an appointment to discuss your child please do so either at the office or after school with your child's teacher directly. This is to protect confidentiality and to ensure the school communicates about matters in a professional environment.
